### **Program Outline**

To earn a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration (BSBA) degree and a Bachelor of Arts in Health Services (BA HLTHSRV) degree, a student must meet the admission requirements of both schools and earn a minimum of 150 credits (minimum of 60 credits for the BSBA, 33 credits for the BA HLTHSRV, and remaining credits in Arts and Sciences/ CGS general education requirements). Note: When substitutions to any HLTHSRV requirements are made, CBA students will choose elective health-care focused courses to fulfill the 33 credit hours required for the HLTHSRV major. Each student will work closely with a CGS advisor to select the electives most appropriate for the student's educational and career goals.
