Choose 12 multidisciplinary courses (or min. 36 credits) for your Liberal Studies major. Each of these courses must relate to your central theme and must be chosen in consultation with your advisor.

At least 15-credits (approx. 5, 3-credit courses) must come from one discipline, which is your primary academic field of study. The remaining related courses may be selected from one or several disciplines within the humanities, social sciences, or natural sciences areas. Professional credits may also be used in the major with approval.

PRIMARY DISCIPLINARY AREA: 15 CREDITS (Approx. 5 Courses)

Informational box containing requirements: Students are required to maintain a minimum of 2.0 GPA and complete at least 120 credits in order to graduate with a BA in Liberal Studies. At least two disciplines must be included in the plan of study. The initial proposal and subsequent changes must go through an approval process. Half of the approved credits that constitute the central theme must be at the-1000 level or equivalent. Up to 12 professional credits can be used in the major. Students are encouraged to pursue an internship / study abroad experience as part of the major. Up to 6 credits are accepted. A maximum of 6 credits with the S/NC grade may be used in the major. At least 30 credits must be earned while in residence at CGS.
