

## Pre-Business Administration Requirements

The College of Business Administration (CBA) offers the Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration (BSBA) with majors in Accounting, Finance, General Management, and Marketing. To earn the BSBA degree, you must complete a minimum of 54 credits in arts and sciences, 42 credits in the core business curriculum, and 15–28 credits in your chosen business major. CGS offers a pre-CBA program designed to take you through the first 30 credits of CBA curriculum, which includes prerequisites and basic courses in mathematics and English.

You will not be eligible to take coursework in the core business curriculum or business major areas until you have been admitted to CBA.

### Admission to CBA

Requirements for guaranteed admission:

1. Completion of at least 30 credits at the University of Pittsburgh, applicable to the BSBA degree, including the required prerequisite coursework.
2. A minimum overall quality point average (QPA) of 2.75 in all courses taken at the University of Pittsburgh.
3. A minimum overall quality point average of 2.75 in the required business prerequisites. Your QPA will be calculated without including the effect of course repeats. The original grade will be counted.

To determine when to begin the admissions process, see your academic consultant.

### Required Business Prerequisite Courses

The following arts and sciences courses (17 credits) are taken through CGS as part of the minimum 30 credits required for admission to CBA. These courses also count toward the BSBA degree. The QPA in these courses will be calculated to determine your admissibility to CBA.

#### Calculus: 4 credits (one course)
