The University of Pittsburgh will accept a maximum of 60 credits from a community college. All courses transfer as lower level, freshman/sophomore level courses. A grade earned in a class taken at CCAC will not replace the grade from an equivalent class taken at the University of Pittsburgh.

Students planning to pursue a major offered through any other school at the University of Pittsburgh should consult the “Pitt Connection” for that school’s transfer policies.

CGS DEGREE REQUIREMENTS
