The University of Pittsburgh College of General Studies (CGS) will transfer a maximum of 60 credits for the Bachelor of Arts degree with a major in administration of justice from the Community College of Allegheny County (CCAC) criminal justice and criminology (law enforcement) program. A grade of C or better is required in each of the courses specified below. Completion of the CCAC program does not guarantee acceptance into the CGS program.
