




# HELPFUL TIPS USING CLASS SEARCH

1. Log into your MyPitt Account at **my.pitt.edu** and search for the **PeopleSoft High Point CX** application. This is your student self service center!




Navigate High Point CX by utilizing the blue menu on the left side on the dashboard and clicking on the **Class Information** icon.

This drop-down menu will grant you access to key information about Gen Eds such as the complete **Course Catalog** and **Class Search** tool.




2. The **Class Search** tool will allow you to search for specific courses at Pitt, as well as filter courses. We can use the filter function to search for specific General Education Requirements.

- ◆ Select the appropriate **Term & Campus**
- ◆ Under **Course Attribute** select *DSAS General Education Requirement*  
\*\*CGS Gen Eds combine courses approved by the Dietrich School and courses from several other disciplines and schools. To see the full list of CGS-approved GEN EDs, refer to the CGS gen ed catalog on our website\*\*
- ◆ Select the **General Education Course Attribute Value** you are looking for
- ◆ Hit **Search** to show results based on the criteria you selected.




