Professional credits may also be used in the major with approval.

Students are required to maintain a **minimum of 2.0 GPA** and complete **at least 120 credits** in order to graduate with a *BA in Liberal Studies*.

At least two disciplines must be included in the plan of study.

The initial proposal and subsequent changes must go through an approval process.

Half of the approved credits that constitute the central theme must be at the-1000 level or equivalent.

Up to 12 professional credits can be used in the major.

Students are encouraged to pursue an internship / study abroad experience as part of the major. Up to 6 credits are accepted.

A maximum of 6 credits with the S/NC grade may be used in the major.

At least 30 credits must be earned while in residence at CGS.
