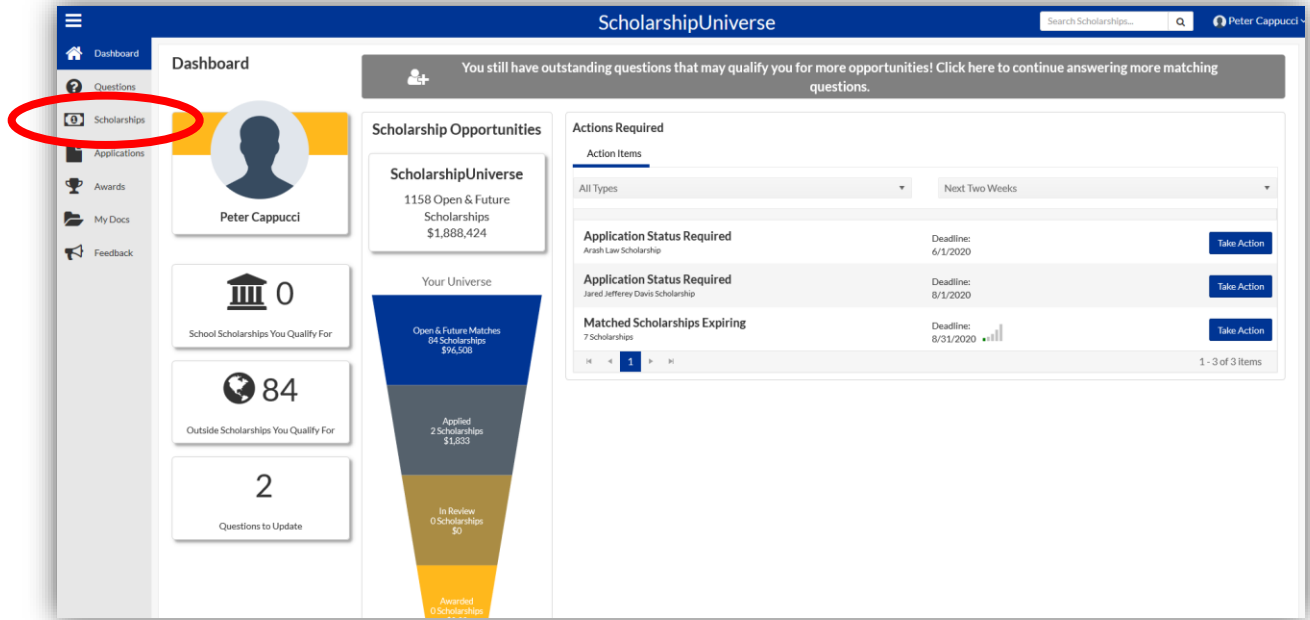
1. Login to my.pitt.edu and click on the “PittFund\$Me” icon



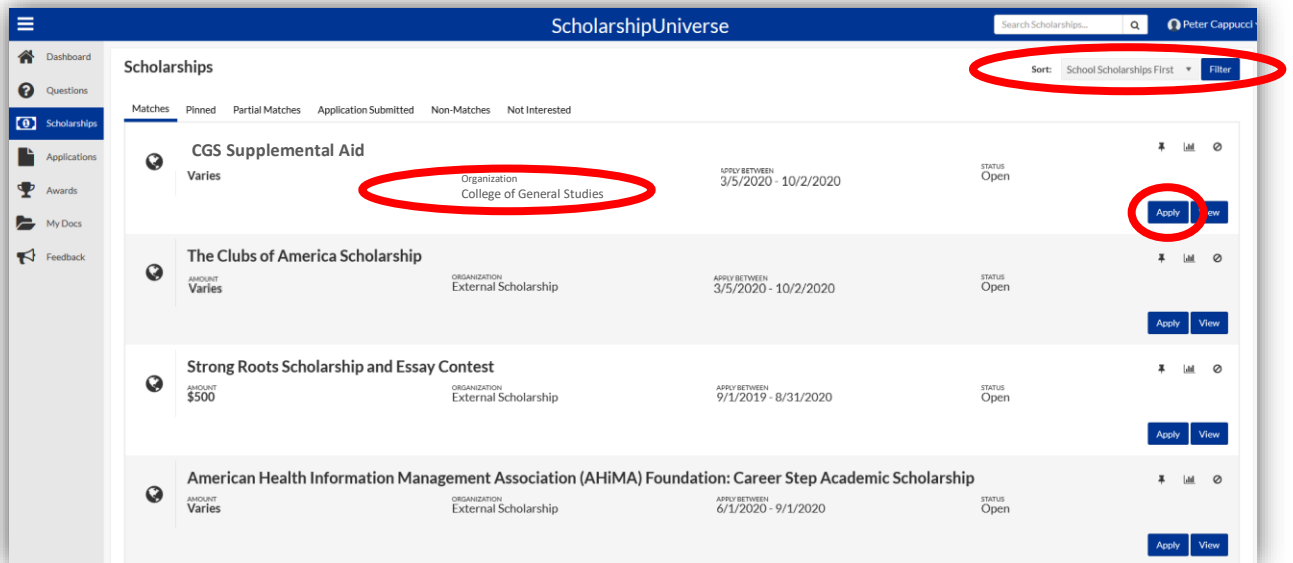
Note: If the icon does not appear use the search box with keywords: 'pittfundsm', 'pittfund\$me' or 'scholarships'
